

Identifying and developing talent in young disabled people

This one day workshop is available for teachers and practitioners who are working with young disabled people in PE and sport. The workshop is a mixture of practical, theory, and interactive sessions, and is hosted by a School Sport Partnership that has demonstrated innovative approaches to supporting talented young disabled people.

The overall aims of the workshops are to support delegates to:

- Better recognise talent in young disabled people through pupil assessment
- Support and develop the talents of young disabled people within the PE curriculum and through school sport
- Effective delivery and development of multi-skills in PE and sport (this is a practical workshop)
- Understand the possible 'next steps' into performance pathways for talented performers
